“ *My Brother Joe*

I remember the day he was born. It was April 19, 1950. I was eight years old, in second grade, and I couldn't wait to share the news with classmates at Show and Tell that my mom had a baby boy, I had a brother! (In those days there were no ultrasounds to reveal the gender of a baby so it was always a big surprise! For the Falco family, it was especially significant because he was the first grandson to carry the Falco name. Regrettably, my grandfather Augustus Falco, passed away of a heart attack before Joe was born. But that didn't make Joe's birth less significant by any means! In fact, it made it even more important! I couldn't wait to get to school to share the news, but unfortunately on Wednesday mornings I went to the Allergy Clinic at Lutheran Hospital with my Aunt Ann and cousin Richard so I would miss the morning at school and so miss Show and Tell. My cousin Dolores, who as in the same class, got to share it first. I was so disappointed! Joe was born early--a little less than eight months gestation I believe, so his beginnings were challenging. I remember that as an infant he had pneumonia and relatives were coming in and out of the apartment to visit. I remember how scared everyone was. He was so tiny, but so beautiful, with clear blue eyes and fair skin. He had a winning smile, even as an infant, and could be easily amused. I don't recall him ever being fussy. Joe was my real live baby doll! Since I was eight years older, he was my first student! I taught him the alphabet, and how to sound out words he could not pronounce. As he grew, I began teaching him how to read. It was so much fun watching him grow up! He was a light-hearted little boy who loved toy cars and trucks, and by the time he was four years old, he knew the names, makes and models of all the automobiles on the road by identifying the hood ornaments. His love of cars lasted throughout adulthood. Years later, "Go Forth And Multiply" as the Bible says, and so he did. He grew up and gave the Falco family a lineage of 14 grand children! He had a full life, and he was be missed dearly by his family and friends.
