The earliest memories of my uncle was at the ripe old age of two when I would go into his room in the morning and wake him up with a very sweet Greek song and lots of hugs and kisses.

I remember him all dressed up on the weekends ready to hit the town dancing the night away. Of course, all the above was before he got married to my aunt Irene. Uncle “Gus” – or *θείο Κώστα* – was an avid dancer who glided elegantly across the floor. Lo and behold if the entertainment agents caught wind of him! Fred Astaire would have had some serious competition because my uncle Costa, in addition to being a superb dancer, also had the drop-dead-gorgeous looks to complete the image of a leading man!

As if that wasn't enough, he could fix anything, build anything and was passionate about his gardening. A master gardener who took pride in his vegetable garden and fruit trees at his estate in Upstate New York, he worked his fields single-handedly and could not wait for the winter frost to subside so that he could devote his spring/summer/autumn months at his estate... memories to last a lifetime...

When my uncle Costa went to the hospital this past February, I feared that I would never again see him alive. I fervently prayed that I would have the opportunity to see him just one more time so that I can tell him how much I loved him, while I still could do so. I will never forget the way his eyes and face lit up when he saw me. He introduced me to all the nurses and CNA's, “this is my niece!”, he said beaming with joy.

This is my last memory of him, one that I will cherish forever. Although my time with him was barely a few minutes, I held his hand, told him how much I loved him and gave him lots of hugs and

kisses. Today, more than ever, I thank God for granting me my wish and allowing me to see him while he was still alive just one last time – enough to tell him how much I love him.

I grieve his loss, a very profound loss, the last direct link to my beloved father, but I know that he is now with my parents and my uncle Mike and his parents. I have this image of him waltzing his way to heaven, straight into the arms of Jesus... I share in the pain of my aunt Irene, my cousins, his grandchildren and his great grandchildren and extend to them my deepest sympathy.
