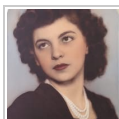

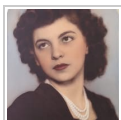

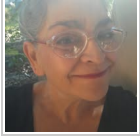

“ Dear Cuz ~

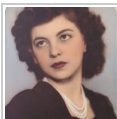

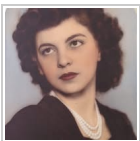
“ Dear Cuz. ~

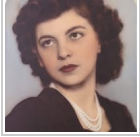
