Klein-Jeanne Marie Muehleisen, December 28, 1939 to March 21, 2024, was the loving wife of Erwin, proud mother of Robert (husband of Brenda) and Katherine (wife of Mark Simko) and caring grandmother of Daniel and Scott Simko.

Jeanne was born in Lancaster, PA and graduated from Hempfield High School in 1957 and worked at Armstrong Cork Company. She met Erwin, the love of her life, while he was a student at Franklin and Marshall College in Lancaster. They were married in 1960 and later moved to the Bronx, Erwin's hometown, and eventually settled down in Williston Park.

When Jeanne was a child, she found a book titled "Long Island" – a book about a little girl who lived on Long Island near beaches and farms. Jeanne loved that story and told her mother she wanted to live there. In 1973 her dream came true-she and Erwin bought a small cape cod style house in Williston Park, Long Island and stayed there for the rest of her life.

Jeanne did volunteer work at Nassau Hospital (now NYU Langone/Winthrop) in 1975, and then was employed by several Long Island colleges and corporations for over 30 years and retired in 2008. Three years later she went back to work-part time- and continued to work until she was 81.

She had a passion for reading and enjoyed doing crossword puzzles and cryptograms. She enjoyed reading about and greatly admired the cryptographers and code breakers from World War II.

Jeanne was a member of the Unitarian Universalist Congregation at Shelter

Rock for many years.

She died in home hospice surrounded by her loving family. In addition to her immediate family, she is survived by a sister, Marilyn Davidson of Lancaster and a brother, Larry of Colorado Springs, CO and several nephews and nieces.
