Kevin Michael Coleman (76) of Scarsdale, NY and Tequesta, FL died unexpectedly on October 1, 2023 at St. Francis Hospital in Roslyn, NY.

The son of William Coleman and Mary O'Leary Coleman, he was born on April 17, 1947 in Paterson, NJ. He is survived by two brothers, Kenneth and Daniel, and was predeceased by his parents and his brother, William. Kevin is also survived by his loving wife of 33 years, Donna Molina Coleman, whom he married on June 2, 1990 in New Rochelle, NY.
