“ My Mom was the 2nd of 3 daughter born to Irish emigrants Jim and Josephine Wilson. The girls were very close in age, 6 years was the difference in ages. Josephine sisters lived only a few blocks away so they all benefited from having family close by.

Mom and her sisters Mary and Ellie, (Eleanor) all attended Catholic school, St. Jeans, Jackson Heights NY. Mom was both a natural athlete and a honors level student who was passionate about learning. Mom would tell us about her triumphs as a point Guard for the St. Jean's H.S. Basketball team.

Until her own passing whenever our Aunt Eleanor spoke about my Mom, she had the love and awe in her voice when she would share with us a few stories about Mom's accomplishments. Mom did not do things to get praise or attention, she was motivated to live by the Golden Rule.

Our Mother's faith was an essential part of Mom's essence and she drew strength from her faith during times of tragedy and sorrow. Mom especially loved the sisters who taught at St. Jeans and she seriously contemplated becoming a nun. However her fate was sealed shortly she finished a Novena to the Blessed Mother asking for guidance about her future-the very next evening at a local CYO Dance, she sense a pair of Blue Eyes staring across the pool at her, that night she met her soulmate, Bill Gold.

When Dad would tell his version of their first meeting he said it was not her beauty which caught his eye, Dad said, "she has this regal bearing about her, there is a Grace about her that I saw as I watched her from across the pool."

For nearly 35 years they shared and built a life together. Dad once said, "People will comment to me or congratulate me on a business success. No one ever realizes it was your Mother who gave me the courage to try something new. People don't realize without your Mother I would have amounted to nothing."

*After her faith in God and her Roman Catholic Religion, the next most important thing in Mom's life was her family. Even as she lost a lot of her mental capacities during the past few years, the staff at Sand's Point Nursing Home would tell us, you can always tell when one of her children visit her, your Mother's face just beams happiness.*

*As an adult Mom had a close circle of friends in the Huntington area where they raised their children. It was strange because with so much responsibility in raising all 11 of us, you could always hear her calling out something positive to each of us during football, baseball, lacrosse, soccer, softball, swimming & diving competitions. For example during a baseball game if you struck out, she would call out that's ok (kids name) you'll get them next time at bat. Dad would chuckle when someone in the stands would criticize the play of one of their children. Dad would tell us the story, Mr. (Blank) learned a lesson today at your brother's football game, when he missed the pass and his play was being vocally criticized, Mr. (Blank) saw another side to your mother's personality. She still conducted herself as a lady but he saw the tigress come out in her, (and then laughing) he would continue God help the person who criticizes Pat Gold's children.*

*As they enjoyed the company of their friends Dad would share with us some of the quips he made at a cocktail part the night before. Dad said I may share a few laughs with a bunch a friends at once, but whenever I would look across the room, there was your mother, engrossed in a conversation with one person, your Mother touches people's souls. They open up to her and share their greatest fears and she usually provides sound guidance or a viable solution.*

*Although I lived in Ireland for 8 years and was told I possess the gift of gab there are no amount of words I can write to attempt to describe the beauty of (Margaret) Patricia/Pat Gold.*

*All I know is that I loved her the way she loved each of us and that*

*was unconditional love.*
