“ How would our mother like to be remembered?

*-As a strong, intelligent, and capable woman who maintained her very sharp intellect until the day she left us.*

*-As a person who wanted to speak for herself and be in control of her own destiny. Giving up or giving in was never in the cards for her- her battle with COVID was the prime example of how she fought so bravely defying the odds and hanging on beyond what most people could have managed. She was a fighter, and her determination was relentless.*

*Our mother Senta -Sandra Deeble had a rich and impressive life- she contributed to the history of our modern world during World War 11 when she served as an intelligence agent for the British Air Force. She lived her life believing that no contribution was too much to be sacrificed for our freedom.*

*Having survived the worst of times during the holocaust and having lost most of her immediate family to the horrors of Auschwitz, she lived her life with determination to overcome oppression of any kind. She was relentlessly stubborn and opinionated, and she was a fighter- all traits which came from her history of survival.*

*How do you even begin to document such a rich life?*

*Those of us who have lived through gentler times will never face or understand the commitment thrust upon these twenty-something wartime survivors. We are so lucky to inherit the history which they provided for us.*

*As a mother of five children with a spouse who was often away on naval assignments, she did her best to provide for us all. Her wartime experiences brought a commitment to having her children always outfitted with warm and comfortable shoes – as a result, we were always outfitted with heavy and supportive Buster Brown shoes and Oxfords- which we all hated.*

*Some memories of our family life were camping trips, Sunday roast beef dinners, way too many dishes to wash, matching Easter outfits which my mother often meticulously made for us, and her handmade Christmas presents- dolls and doll clothing and fruit baskets converted into doll beds. She was a woman of many*

*talents.*

*She was a voracious reader and was always on top of current events. She loved supporting people less fortunate – I remember when we were young, she would buy groceries for kids at school who came from those families, and she would drag us around in the car while she delivered them so we would learn the importance of giving. She had many charities to which she donated regularly but she had a particular fondness for all animals and supported every four-legged cause by donating as well as adopting pets of all kinds.*

*I spoke with my mother regularly on the phone and until she was stricken with her recent hospital stay, I enjoyed very long, lucid, intelligent, humorous and informative conversations with her. She never lost her intellect, and she was so much fun to chat with- those calls will be missed. It is hard to think that they will no longer be possible.*

*My regret is that her rich history of survival is now lost and that we were not able to fully capture it because she was unable to open the door to share such painful memories.*
