Susan Ellen (Babbit) Moss, formerly Bria, 76, of Sayville, NY, passed away on May 13th, 2026 after a short illness.

Susan was born on November 9, 1949 in Queens, NY to Seymour “Sy” and Pearl (Stark) and soon after moved to Jericho, NY, with her sisters Leslie and Jamie. Several years later Pearl and the girls headed back west to Lefrak City, Queens. Thirteen years ago she reconnected with her childhood friend Bert and found love again. Together they spent their golden years living on the water, traveling, dancing and laughing through life's new adventure, highlighted by their 2022 nuptials.
