“ Billy was one of ten children from a broken family ravaged by violence and alcohol. His sister (Kathleen) died shortly before Billy was born. The twins (Frieda, Rosemarie) along with the triplets (Sally, Jeanne, Fred) were placed in a series of foster homes. At age 9, Billy, along with his three brothers (Johnny, Jimmy, Dennis) were placed in St. Agnes (aka 'The Home'), a Catholic institution for boys (about 500 kids). St. Agnes was very strict with harsh discipline. At age 17, Billy left St. Agnes and soon after joined the Marine Corps where he got his GED.

His working years were spent primarily in the elevator industry. For many, many years his nights were spent at universities taking up a broad range of subjects: Mechanics, Electronics, Computer Languages, Artificial Intelligence, Music, Cooking, Celestial Navigation, Astronomy, Geology, etc., etc.

During power blackouts he helped rescue people from stuck elevators. He designed a couple of elevator devices, one of which got patented. Billy helped form two companies, one of which, Claddagh Electronics, is still here today.

Eventually, the broken family got reunited on July 13, 2002 when a grand family reunion was held. Annual reunions continued from that point on, with the last being held at Billy's favorite restaurant.

Billy said, "I was blessed with curiosity, but also cursed with it. My life was very good, no complaints, just different."
